David Giedroc graduated from the Pennsylvania State University in 1980 with a B.S. in Biochemistry. He earned a Ph.D. in Biochemistry at Vanderbilt University in 1984. In 2007, he became Professor of Chemistry at Indiana University where he has continued his studies of transcriptional metalloregulatory proteins. He has served as a member of the Editorial board for Journal of Biological Chemistry and is a member in the advisory board for Metallomics.
