## **Gregory H. Robinson**

*Foundation Distinguished Professor of Chemistry,  
The University of Georgia*

Gregory Robinson earned a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Jacksonville State University (Jacksonville, Alabama), where he was also a four-year letterman on the Gamecock football team earning All-American honors his senior year. He obtained his doctorate in chemistry from The University of Alabama (Tuscaloosa), and began his academic career at Clemson University (South Carolina). A decade later he moved to The University of Georgia, where he holds the title of Foundation Distinguished Professor of Chemistry. His list of professional awards includes the Southeastern Conference Faculty Achievement Award, the American Chemical Society F. Albert Cotton Award in Synthetic Inorganic Chemistry, the Alexander von Humboldt Research Prize, the Southern Chemist Award, the Herty Medal, the Percy Julian Award, the Stone Award, and the Lamar Dodd Creative Research Award (the highest research award of The University of Georgia).
